Internal assessments revealed that a significant portion of textile offcuts previously lost to waste were suitable for upcycling, demonstrating the potential to convert discarded materials into new, high-value apparel and accessories. Such initiatives reflect a growing commitment among African manufacturers to reduce manufacturing waste, enhance sustainability performance, and meet the expectations of international buyers seeking responsible suppliers...

Circularity is also expanding beyond large factories. Grassroots and mid-sized enterprises are establishing collection, sorting, and upcycling systems that give new life to post-consumer textiles. These waste-to-value networks reduce landfill pressure, create employment opportunities, and support the shift toward locally anchored circular value chains. Together, these developments illustrate Africa's growing capability to integrate circular solutions across formal and informal manufacturing systems.

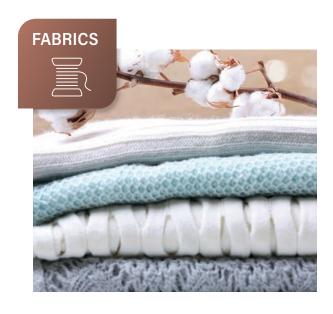
